Dear Brothers and Sisters,

One of the last acts of Jesus as He was dying on the Cross was to entrust the care of His Mother to the care of His disciple, John,

Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother's sister, Mary the *wife* of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing by, He said to His mother, "Woman, behold your son!" Then He said to the disciple, "Behold your mother!" And from that hour that disciple took her to his own *home*. (John 19:25-27, NKJV)

There was, of course, a practical significance to this: someone had to take care of Jesus' aging Mother after His death. Mary had no other children, and it was very difficult for women to live on their own in the Ancient Near East. But the very fact that these words made it into the Gospel shows that they have a greater-than-practical significance. The vast majority of Jesus' interactions with His Mother were not written down in Scripture, so what was recorded must only have been included because of its unique relevance to later generations. And the Church has always understood Jesus' words "Behold your mother" as being directed at all of those who would follow Him. Jesus commands His disciple John to take her as his Mother, because all of His disciples must take her as their Mother.

In the centuries following Jesus' Ascension into Heaven, the Orthodox Church has enthusiastically responded to His commandment. From the earliest days, Mary was understood to have a special role in the life and history of the Church, as witnessed by her depictions in the Gospels of Luke and John and the images and prayers to her which began to appear in the first centuries of Christianity. By the Third Ecumenical Council in 431 AD, it was determined that those who do not honor her as "Theotokos" ("One-who-gave-birth-to-God") is a heretic, someone outside of the boundaries of Orthodoxy. To this day she is honored continuously with icons, churches, prayer services and holidays dedicated to her. The faithful of the Orthodox Church deeply understand her to be our Mother.

But it must be mentioned, that the Church is not alone in responding positively to Christ's commandment — Mary has shown herself to be obedient to the Lord, even long after her earthly life. She lovingly embraces all believers as her own children when they call on her with faith. Whether causing healing springs to bubble up from the ground in ancient Constantinople, appearing to Greek soldiers on the front line in the Second World War, or

causing myrrh to flow from icons in modern day America, the Mother of God continues to actively manifest her presence in the life of the Church.

August is the time when we particularly honor the Theotokos with fasting and daily Paraklesis services in anticipation of the commemoration of her Dormition (death) on August 15th. I ask all Orthodox Christians in our parish to observe the fast, come to church, and make an extra effort to do good during the first 14 days of August, and in that way to show love to our heavenly Mother.


